Jewish Christians

What is at stake is the **gospel of Jesus Christ**



Righteousness of God comes only by faith in Jesus Christ and to all (without discrimination) who believe in Him



Righteousness of God through Christ must, in turn, shape the way we live as individuals and as a community

Background



(c.f. Acts 17:1-10)

At Thessalonica, Paul ministered the gospel for about three weeks

Because of **persecutions**, Paul has to flee and leave behind **young believers**

Paul sends Timothy to see how they are continuing in their faith despite persecutions

Timothy returns to Paul with a **glowing report** of the Thessalonian believers' faith and testimony

Looking at... The Thessalonian Church

(that is **young** but **growing** steadily)



- For this reason,
 when I could bear it no longer,
 I sent to learn about your faith,
 for fear that somehow the tempter had
 tempted you and our labor would be in vain
- 6 But now that Timothy has come to us from you, and has brought us the good news of your faith and love
 - and reported that you always remember us kindly and long to see us, as we long to see you

Context of 1 Thessalonians

God's people are to continue in the good work that God has started in their lives

- 1 Believers display remarkable faith, love and hope
- 2 Believers truly share and receive God's word



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

Background



Peter writes to believers in the five provinces in the northwest of Asia Minor, namely, Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia and Bithynia

These believers were being persecuted and treated like "strangers, foreigners, exiles" because of their faith in Christ





Paul writes to urge them to live **holy** lives and respond **Christianly** in the context of **hostility** and **suffering**

The believers are to remember how **privileged** they are in Christ and to **pattern** their lives **after Jesus** who suffered and died for us

Looking at... The Persecuted Churches

(that are **suffering hardships** due to their **faith**)



1 Pet 4

- Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery trial when it comes upon you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you.
- But rejoice insofar as you share Christ's sufferings,

that you may also rejoice and be glad when his glory is revealed.

If you are insulted for the name of Christ, you are blessed, because the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you.

 with humility toward one another,
 for "God opposes the proud
 but gives grace to the humble."
- 6 **Humble yourselves**, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you,
- 7 casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you.

c.f. Heb 13

7 Remember your leaders, those who spoke to you the word of God.

Consider the outcome of their way of life, and imitate their faith.

Gentiles, from Jerusalem to Judea and Samaria

Background

The witness extends from the apostles to

others; the gospel went from Jews to

Judea and Samaria

and subsequently even further to Europe and Rome

The church started with a group of believers (led by the apostles) seeking the Lord in word and prayer

With the **Spirit's empowerment**, the apostles **preached the gospel boldly**; the Lord added growth to the church which was marked by its unity and generosity

The church faced many external threats
(in the form of persecutions) and internal threats
(in their ethnic diversities)


