- I. Asked God to answer his prayer quickly
 - v1. answer quickly
 - v2. accept prayer as aroma

- II. Asked God to guard his life from wrong doing
 - v3. his mouth
 - v4. his heart
 - v4. his deeds
 - v5. rebuke welcome

- III. Wicked will be judged surely
 - v6. wicked leaders thrown down
 - v7. their bones scattered in shame

- IV. Petition for deliverance from traps
 - v8. seeks refuge in God
 - v9. to be kept from the traps
 - v10. he walks safely

An evening prayer of lament asking God to accept his prayers – that he be prevented from sinning against God and to walk safely while the wicked falls into his own trap.
